Have you ever wondered what Clifton Christian Church Food Bank really means to our community? Let me share a story from last Friday. One of our volunteers, who

is also a church member, was helping out at our drive-through pantry. A client came through looking upset and our volunteers, who are the face of Jesus to people, asked if she was okay. She broke into tears and shared that she had just lost her 8-year-old grandson to an illness. She had been sitting at home alone, not knowing what to do next, when she remembered the food bank was open that day. She told the volunteer that yes, she needed the food to help her family, but more importantly, she sought love, kindness, and prayers from the Clifton Christian Church Food Bank. We always strive to be Jesus to our community, just as He has taught us to do.

Do you want to be a part of something amazing right here in our community???

We consider ourselves incredibly blessed as followers of Jesus because we witness His work daily at the food bank. Last year alone, we helped nearly 65,000 individuals, providing them with essentials like frozen meat, dairy, fresh produce, and non-perishable items. But I like the book of Acts. "The Lord added to their number daily those who are being saved" (2:47)". Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ. (5:42).

It's been said that preachers have said, "Revival is just the church getting back to normal." Or even better, Vance Havner said, "Revival is the church falling in love with Jesus all over again." I think revival can still be an effective tool.

Northeast Thailand

Jeff & Mary – Serving the Thai People

December was an encouraging and faith-building month as God moved powerfully through Christmas outreach efforts in Northeast Thailand. On **December 20**, Jeff and Mary hosted their **first Christmas program at a rubber tree farm** where their team has been building relationships throughout the year. Although they expected about ten people, **more than forty attended**.

The program included Christmas hymns, games, and a clear presentation of the **Gospel and the true meaning of Christmas**. Many expressed gratitude and joy for the event.

Families were also invited to a larger Christmas outreach at the church on **December 26**. Despite the **25-minute distance**, several families from the farm attended, greatly encouraging the team. It is our prayer that the ministry at the rubber tree farm will continue to grow.

For the main outreach, fellow missionary **Ryan** partnered by providing meals through his food truck ministry in Udon Thani. He prepared food for **100 people**, and God faithfully provided—**every person was fed, with nothing left over**.

The Gospel message traces God's redemptive story from the fall in Eden to the birth of Christ and the gift of grace through His sacrifice. Attendance was so large that **chairs had to be borrowed from a neighboring church**.

Violet and Naomi baked **over 300 cookies** for Christmas invitations, and their oldest son, Josiah, faithfully served by cooking throughout the entire event.

Despite these blessings, **Thailand remains a spiritually challenging place**. Please pray for endurance, joy, and deep love for the Thai people, as fruit sometimes appears slowly.

Kulpahar Christian School & Mission

Kulpahar, India

The Kulpahar mission is experiencing a season of **deep sorrow and challenge**. A beloved grandson, Ezra, a 12th-grade student, passed away suddenly due to a severe asthma attack. The school was closed in love and respect for his family.

At the same time, the mission and school are facing **staff conflicts and division**, placing heavy emotional and physical strain on long-term missionaries **Linda** (serving since 1975) and **Sharon** (serving since 1995). The school now serves nearly **1,000 students**, and the hostel cares for **98 children**.
