MARCH Missions Spotlight (Global Missions)

“Declare His glory among the nations. His marvelous works among all peoples.”

Psalm 96:3

AFRICA: EB Charity Foundation

The ministry continues to advance the Gospel while serving children and families through outreach, education, and practical support.

1. Evangelism Outreach – February 28

An evangelism outreach is planned to share the Gospel and minister to children and families.

🙏 Prayer Focus:

Pray for divine appointments, open hearts, protection for the team, and that many people encounter Christ through this outreach.

2. Feeding Program

A feeding program will follow the outreach to provide physical nourishment and demonstrate Christ's love in action.

🙏 Prayer Focus:

Pray for the provision of resources, faithful volunteers, and that every child feels valued and cared for through this expression of compassion.

3. Community Library Initiative – Zambia

Two shipments of books are currently held up at customs. Books continue to be collected with plans to establish another library in Zambia to expand educational opportunities and community impact.

🙏 Prayer Focus:

Pray for favor with customs officials, release of the shipments, continued provision of books and supplies, and successful establishment of the new library.

Zion Bible College – Eswatini

The end-of-year accounting revealed another theft incident, requiring administrative action and accountability measures. An employee was asked to sign documentation regarding the matter. With the school year beginning on February 3, leadership has faced challenges while maintaining stability and operations.

🙏 Prayer Focus:

Pray for integrity, financial restoration, wisdom for leadership, justice in administrative matters, protection over school resources, and strength for staff and students throughout the academic year.

Prayer for Missionaries in Politically Challenging Nations

There is concern for missionaries serving in regions with political instability and social uncertainty, particularly in Mexico, Colombia, Africa, and parts of the Middle East.

🙏 Prayer Focus:

Pray for protection, wisdom, boldness, and provision for missionaries and their families. Pray for safety in ministry, favor with local authorities, and that the Gospel continues to advance despite challenges.
