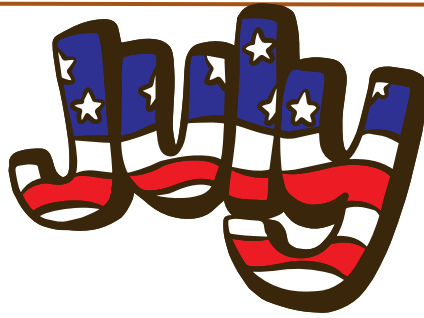

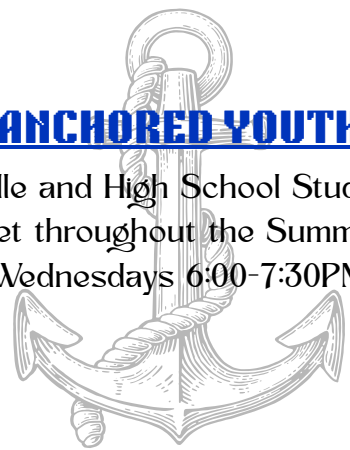

## NEWS FROM THE CLIFTON CHRISTIAN

### CHURCH FOOD BANK:

It's hard to believe we've already reached July 2026. Reflecting on the first six months at the Clifton Christian Church Food Bank, we're grateful for the impact we've made together. So far, we have provided food to over 25,000 individuals, thanks to the dedication of our volunteers who have contributed 3,500 hours of service. Our program expenditures amounted to \$82,455.64, while total revenue—including grants, business donations, tithing from CCC and other churches, and individual contributions—reached \$71,580.11.

As Jesus reminds us in Matthew 6:31-33, we need not worry about food or clothing, for our heavenly Father knows our needs and provides when we seek His Kingdom first.

We are deeply thankful and blessed for all that God continues to provide through the food bank.

We are continually seeking volunteers to support our food bank throughout the week, and we also offer numerous outreach opportunities for those eager to get involved. Your prayers and financial contributions are deeply appreciated, and we are truly grateful for your ongoing support.

We're keeping all firefighters and farmers in our thoughts and prayers as they navigate the challenges of this drought season.

## MISSION NEWS FROM AROUND THE WORLD!

### **OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD IS RIGHT AROUND THE CORNER...**

How exciting is it to be your own mini missionary without even leaving our towns in Colorado?! It's all about Jesus and sharing his Gospel and love with children all around the world!

Every child needs Christ! Samaritan's Purse sends Operation Christmas Child shoebox gifts to boys and girls living in major cities, dense jungles, arid deserts, war zones, remote islands, and along lofty mountain ranges. They work closely with local teams to bring these special gifts to children in need, even hard-to-reach areas where there are few believers or where many have long been hostile to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Some of their newest initiatives increase the accessibility of resources: translating materials into minor languages, using audio translations where there is no written language, developing Braille resources for blind and visually impaired children, and reaching the deaf community. God is using Operation Christmas Child shoebox gifts to transform the lives of children around the world! Each box is packed full of fun, quality toys, school supplies, personal care items and most importantly PRAYER! As a result of sending your box(es), lives are changed, children are disciplined, and whole communities are transformed. Since 1993, Operation Christmas Child has delivered gift filled shoeboxes to over 244 million children in more than 175 countries and territories.

I will have all the needed materials---boxes, labels, and instructions sometime in mid-October. National Collection Week will be November 16-23. There will be a display table in the Great Hall. I know many of you are already thinking ahead and purchasing your items in anticipation of your commitment to the Lord's children. Can you imagine never having seen a stuffed animal or crayons and paper? God knows exactly which child needs your shoebox!
